



At this year's MCN Awards, Triumph walked away with 6 awards including the coveted Manufacturer of the Year and Overall Bike of the Year.

Triumph has won Overall Bike of the Year for 3 years consecutively with the Speed 400 securing the accolade for 2024. The previous winners in the model line-up were: Tiger Sport 660 (2022) and the Street Triple RS (2023).





Triumph Owners' Motor Cycle Club Club Rules April 2023


The Triumph Owners' Motor Cycle Club" shall be the official name of the organisation: hereinafter called the Club.

2. The aims and objects of the Club are to provide facilities for members to meet in a spirit of friendship and to promote all aspects of motorcycling.

3. The Club shall consist of Regions and Branches which together form the whole. Regions and Branches shall be self-organising subject to their responsibility to the Club and Club Rules. (2020)

Each Branch has a managing Committee, elected annually by members. Branches provide a focus for members to meet, ride together, attend shows and other events, and to help each other with information about Triumph motorcycles and riding in general.

Branch members are encouraged to participate both in other Branch's events and at the National level.
